

1. Growing interactions between climate change and poverty, bigger threat to poverty eradication

- 1.1 China's basic facts regarding climate change and poverty
- 1.11 natural dizaster prone many types in large parts of the country, deep and wide impacts- growing numbers and impacts due to global warming
- 1.12 Poor population concentrated in western and central China with lousy natural conditions and vulnerable eco-system. Nationally identified contiguous poor areas are largely ecologically vulnerable

Decreasing food productivity, increases the risk on the poor, especially the most vulnerable

2.China's responses to the negative impacts of climate change on the poor

- 2.1 macropolicy- eco improvement efforts started in 1978: "three-north shelterbelt forestry", "eco-friendly relocation", "eleventh 5-year plan" and "twelfth 5-year plan" demonstrated the central government's minds to put people first and determintations to search a green growth path
- 2.2 specific poverty reduction program: offset the poverty impacts of climate change
 - 2.22 institutional build-up
 - 2.23 specific poverty reduction program



3.Challenges in the future

- 3.1 huge size, poverty remained in areas with least natural endowment, a hard-to-address situation
- 3.2 poor payment eco-system service in the country, not reaching the poor
- 3.2 high threashold in global carbon finance, the poor hardly benefited
